Award: The Parkview PTSA shall provide two scholarships in the amount of \$500.00 each toward the educational costs at an accredited college, university, or technical school. The \$500.00 “Most Inspiring Teacher” Scholarships will be selected primarily on the basis of an essay written by the student describing a Parkview Teacher who has inspired you to achieve. If you are selected, the teacher will also receive \$100.00 to be used in the classroom

Objective: The PTSA Scholarship Committee requests each applicant to submit a two page double-spaced essay describing a Parkview teacher, currently working at any level, who has inspired you to achieve. The Committee will also consider other criteria including academic ability; scholastic honors and awards; extracurricular honors, awards and activities in both school and community; and work experience.

Eligibility: All Parkview High School seniors. Any student receiving a full scholarship is NOT eligible. The PTSA Scholarship Committee shall review the applications and select the students who best meet the criteria.

Deadline: Applications must be received in Mrs. Todd’s counseling office no later than Friday April 18, 2008.

Announcement: The scholarship recipient will be announced during the April 29, 2008 Senior Honors Night ceremony.
